I can just record in my lesson, at home, or at my concert, and save money.

This is true. If there is a performance that you are very happy with in one of these venues, then you might consider having the recording mastered here at the Studio to make it sound even better (to reduce hiss or extraneous noises, adjust EQ, or add compression or reverb).

However, at BPC Recording (as with any recording studio) a great deal of care and expense has been invested to have the finest instrument and equipment available to its clients. This effort is reflected in every end product we produce – a CD where you sound better than you do in your lesson, at home, or at your concert.

You are here at the studio to do one thing – to make music the best way you know how without any other distractions. The relatively small investment it takes to produce a professional sounding and looking CD will pay off enormously toward your future goals.

It is *our* goal to help take you there as simply as possible.
